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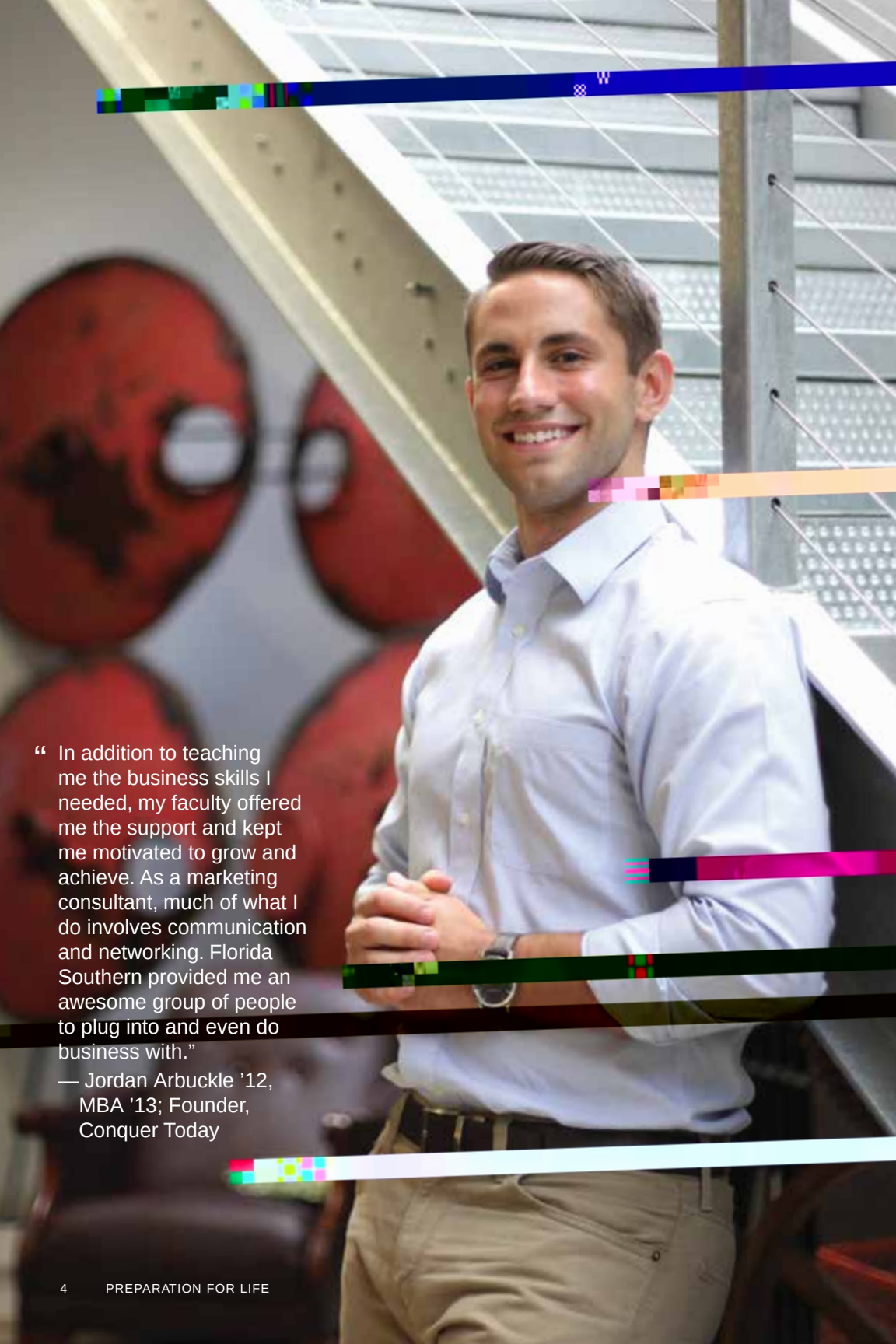

Florida Southern's liberal arts focus instills critical qualities in students, helping them become flexible, creative, and communicative adults.

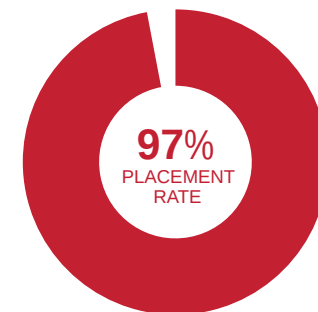

COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH

Our students work alongside faculty contributing to new discoveries, co-authoring articles in scientific journals, and presenting their findings at national conferences. Through our Faculty-Student Collaboration Initiative, students gain firsthand experience and prepare for graduate school by assisting with research projects.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Logging more than 32,000 hours of service annually, students and faculty make a difference in the lives of others — from Lakeland to Tanzania. INTERNSHIPS

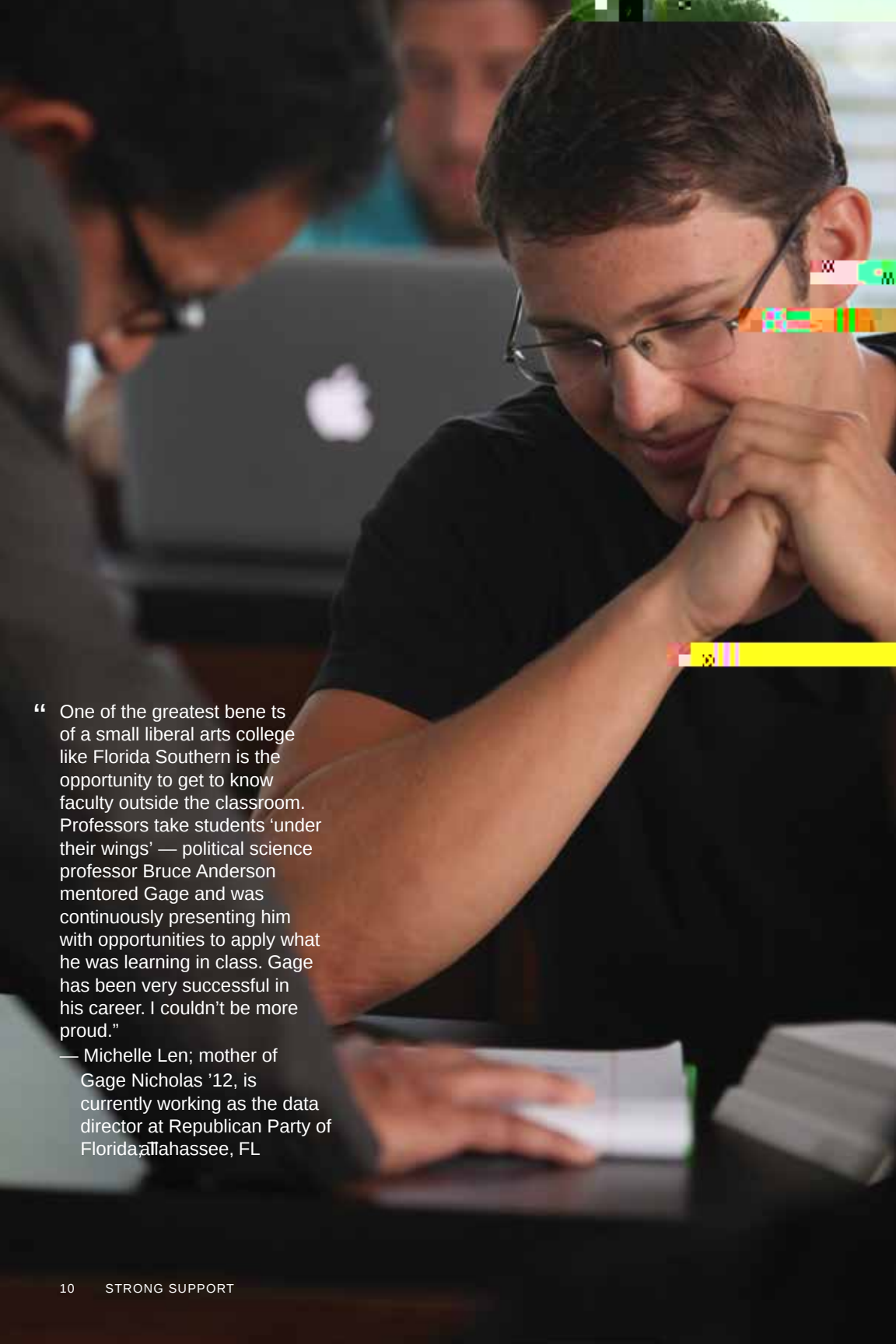

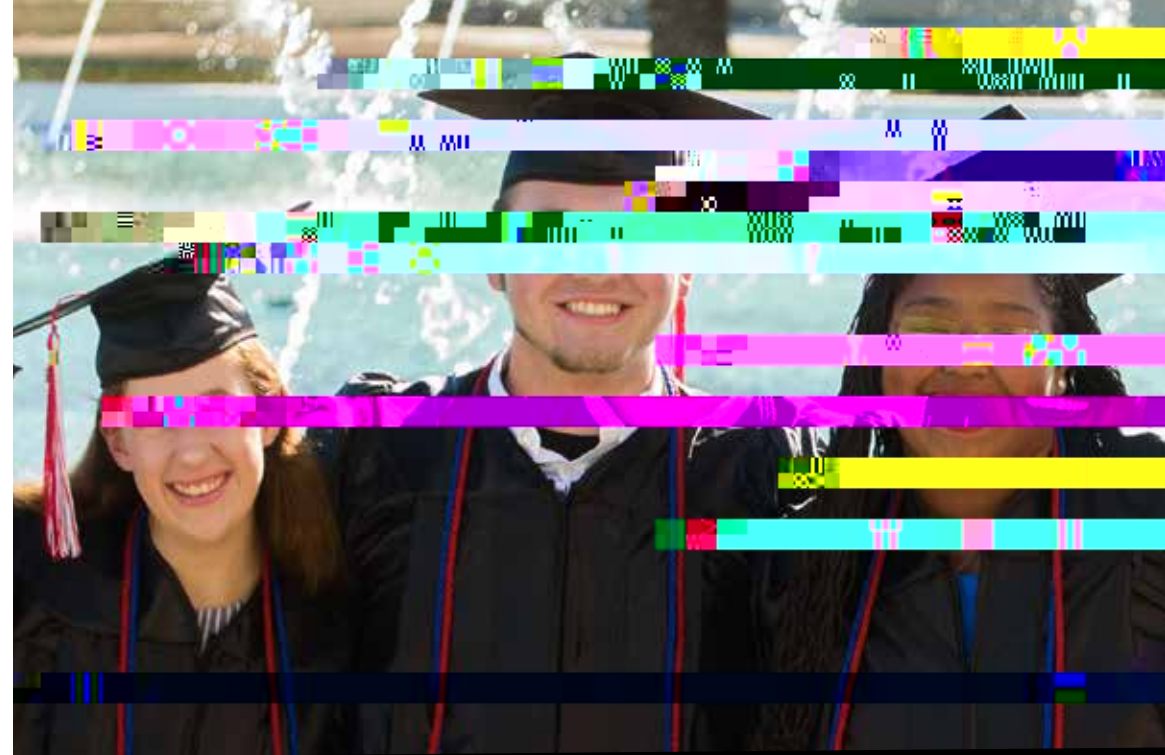
