SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP) POLICY

FEDERAL AID PROGRAMS

Federal aid recipients must complete 12 credits, or at least 67% of credits attempted eactinterindetermination of continued eligibility is made at the end of the spring semester. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required of all students. Students are eligible for federal aid for a maximum of 12 semesters oftifule study, and courses may be repeated only as prescribed in the Catalog. Students can receive federal aid for a maximum of 150% of their academic program.

acceptable reasons for appeal would be the death of a relative of the student, an injury or illness of the student, or other documents special circumstances. An appeal may be approved only if the school has determined that the student will be able to meet SAP standards after the subsequent payment period; or develops an academic plan with the student that, if followed, with the student is able to meet SAP standards by a specific point in time. Students who have an approved appeal will be adleiwed to r federal aid for a maximum of one probationary semester. Financial aid probation is a status assigned to a student what fails t satisfactory academic progress and who has appealed and has had eligibility for aid reinstated. After the probationary period, students who have successfully eliminated their SAP deficiency will receive federal aid in their award letter if otherwise eligible.
